A BYLAW WITH RESPECT TO LIVE STOCK AND POULTRY

The Council of the Town of La Ronge in the Province of Saskatchewan, chacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "The Livestock and Poultry Bylaw".
- 2. DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw the term:

- (a) COUNCIL shall mean the Council of the Town of La Ronge.
- (b) PERSON includes a corporation or a partnership as well as natural persons.
- (c) TOWN shall mean the Town of La Ronge, Saskatchewan.
- 3. No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the Town.
- 4. No person shall graze cattle, nor shall any cattle be permitted to graze at any time within the Town.
- 5. No person shall keep horses, cattle, or other live stock, poultry, piged foxes, mink, rabbits or any animals reared for the bearing of fur, or any of them within the limits of the Town without the written permission of the Council and then only:
 - (a) in locations specified by resolution of Council,
 - (b) within an enclosure especially erected for such purpose and approved by the Council.
- 6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the Town.
