Crokicurl in La Ronge!

The Rules:

- The game is played with two teams. Each team is composed of 1-2 players. Teams of 1, play from opposing sides; for teams of 2, players from the same team play from opposing sides and each player is limited to 1 side. Each team has 6 rocks of the same colour.
- A crokicurl shot is accomplished by firmly sliding a rock onto the playing surface, releasing before the starting line. The rock may be played from any point within the assigned side. (use your imagination where the half way point is...) Players are permitted to place their feet against the side rail while shooting the rock.
- The first player will try to score 20 points with their shot by shooting a rock into the centre button. If the rock successfully lands completely within the button it is removed and set aside to count as 20 points at the end of the round.
- Subsequent shots attempt to remove an opponent rock from the playing surface, unless there are no rocks on the playing surface. If the rock fails to make contact with an opponent rock, the rock is removed from the game. At the same time, each player attempts to make a 20 point shot difficult for the opposing team.
- No player may enter the coloured point rings during game play until all rocks have been played by both teams and scoring is being determined. The exception to this is when a team scores 20 points with their rock entering the button or to remove a rock that failed to make contact with an opponent rock.
- Players may not change sides during a round.
- Play proceeds in a clockwise fashion, alternating each team and player.
- A rock that lands more than halfway over the outer edge of the outside line, it will be removed from game play.
- Scoring occurs after all rocks have been played. Between 2 Blue lines is 5 points, between the blue line & the red line is 10 point and between the red line and the centre hole is 15 points. Teams can play to a pre-determined score. The player or team with the higher score wins the round. The winner of the match is determined by the team who wins the most rounds, best of 1, 3, 5, 7, etc.
